A legacy blooms



Amy J. Vilz, a UB librarian who loved history, gardening, and travel, has generously established a memorial fund to support one of her favorite events, Garden Walk Buffalo.

Vilz died on March 4, 2021, at 47, after a battle with cancer.

Through a bequest managed by the Community Foundation of Greater Buffalo, Amy leaves a living legacy that will continue

to spread beauty and joy for years to come.

A native of Buffalo, Vilz graduated from the University at Buffalo with history and MLS degrees. She became head archivist for University Libraries at UB in 2013.

Amy planned her whole life to buy a house, plant a garden and see the world, and reaching those goals helped sustain her during her illness. She lived doing what she loved, whether it was tossing coins into Rome's Trevi Fountain or working side-by-side with her mother, Jeanne Vilz, to wrap Amy's brand-new Kenmore home in beds of colorful perennials. She said it best in her self-written obituary:

"In lieu of flowers, plant some...Plant roots for the future!"

East Side Garden Walk news



The East Side Garden Walk has partnered with the Michigan Street African American Heritage Corridor **Commission and the African** Heritage Food Co-op to fight food insecurity on Buffalo's East Side. This program, Mrs. Frances Nash's Garden Basket, will provide farm-fresh fruits and vegetables to those in need - more than 200 people a week will have access to high nutritional value foods for free throughout the 2022 growing season. With your support this program can service up to 400 people a week. Donating today at MichiganStreetBuffalo.org/gardenbasket.



Ground will be broken this summer to create more dignified surroundings at the Freedom Wall (Michigan St at E Ferry St), a mural celebrating African American leaders' historic and ongoing work for political and social equality. Thanks to the East Side Garden Walk Committee, in collaboration with Niagara Frontier Transportation Authority, the Michigan Street African American Heritage Corridor Commission, and a \$366,000 grant from Senator Kennedy, the area between the wall and street curb will be improved and LED lighting will be installed to accent the wall portraits.
